Parking – parking will be \$5. Per car for everyone. It was deemed that DOGtoberfest had surpassed attendance levels that make public safety mandatory. The YCSO posse has been deputized to keep order during our event, ensure the safety of visitors and control traffic.

The parking fee is our donation to the Posse for their services.

Check-in **Please allow our volunteers to confirm your final booth number before you start unloading.**

Set up - starts at 7AM Everyone should be ready by 9:30. Not too much to set up? Sleep in.... a bit.

Unloading Areas – There are three unloading areas. (See enclosed map)

Area **A** is for the **SPONSORS**.

Area **B** is for the **PERFORMANCE GROUPS**.

Area **C** is for the **RESCUES**.

These unloading areas will get you the closest to the area of your set up. Those who are not directly assisting in unloading need to park in the parking area by the main gate, then join you at your set-up location.

UNLOADING ONLY- Please, after unloading your cargo, move your vehicle...BEFORE you work to complete setting up. Time and volunteer assistance is limited to get everyone unloaded and set up. Vehicles need to be moved to the parking area by the main entrance of the park. Remember, others will be waiting to unload.

At 10AM All of the parking spaces that line Watson Lake Rd will be deemed handicapped parking.

Booth Markers – All booth locations will be marked, please hold on to the white stake. Someone will be by to pick it up

Flags- Small marking flags around the grounds, will mark sprinkler heads, please don't move or remove.

Canopies – All canopies need to be secure at all times, weights or stakes are both OK.

Stakes – Stakes up to 12" are fine. Anything longer than 12" is prohibited.

Tie-Downs – Please be sure that tie-downs go straight down, versus out at an angle, where people can trip.

Backs and sides – Booth backs are encouraged, but as a courtesy to those around you, don't block their view. Rescues/Performance Groups are exempt from this due to their canine shade requirements.

Visitor Friendly – Please be sure that your area is visitor friendly;(inviting, neat, hazard free and well signed).

Giveaways – Giveaways and drawings are encouraged. Both are great conversations starters.
