- Senior pets are often already housetrained, or can be more easily housetrained than a young pet with a tiny bladder.
- You can teach an old dog new tricks! Seniors have the attention span and impulse control that makes them easier to train than their youthful counterparts.
- Seniors are often content to just relax in your company, unlike younger pets, who may get into mischief because they're bored.
- A senior golden won't grow any larger, so you'll know exactly how much pet you're getting.
- Consider a senior golden a retiree, rather than a high-energy young dog who will run you ragged. Not that older dogs don't require any exercise, they do—but they're not going to need. or want, to run a marathon.
- Older dogs have learned what "no" means.
- Older dogs leave you time for yourself, because they don't make the kinds of demands on your time and attention that puppies and young dogs do.
- Older goldens settle in easily, because they've earned what it takes to get along with others and become part of a pack.
- Seniors let you get a good night's sleep because they're accustomed to human schedules and don't generally need nighttime feedings, comforting, or bathroom breaks.
